## Canadian Intellectual Property Office Extends All Deadlines to May 1, 2020

As expected, as part of its ongoing efforts to manage the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Canadian Intellectual Property Office (CIPO) has prolonged the automatic extension period beyond the original April 1, 2020 date.

Any deadlines fixed under the *Trademarks Act*, *Patent Act*, and the *Industrial Design Act* falling between March 16, 2020 and April 30, 2020 have now been extended to **May 1, 2020**. Once again, CIPO has noted that it may prolong the extension period beyond that date should these circumstances continue.
