ABOUT THE GRANT

- Open to Canadian for-profit businesses that have been incorporated for at least two years and in which 51% or more of the owners or shareholders self-identify as Black.
- Applicant businesses must have their head office located in Toronto, Vancouver, or Calgary.
- Grant recipients will be eligible to receive grant funds and matching pro bono legal advice with a cumulative value of up to \$80,000. To date, 26 recipients have shared in total grant and legal services pool worth \$1.26 million.
- This year, applications are open from September 15 to October 16.
